

Youth Leadership Knoxville is a program that gives area high school students a chance to enhance their knowledge of Knoxville and develop leadership skills that will encourage and motivate them to become involved and committed to their community.

Students from Knox County high schools who will be juniors during the 2018 - 2019 school year are eligible to apply.

Selection Process

The YLK Selection Committee will select 35-40 participants for the program based on the candidate's application and references. The Selection Committee may or may not be unaware of the identity of the candidates. Participants will be notified of acceptance in April 2018. An orientation session will be held in June for all participants and their parents or guardians. Tuition is not due before acceptance, but is due upon acceptance to hold a student's spot in the class.

How to apply

1. The student must complete pages 2-5 of the application.
*If your application is not complete, your application may not be considered.
2. The student must sign their name at the bottom of page 4.
3. Complete the essays to your application. It is OK to type as an attachment.
4. Request that your references complete the forms (pages 6 and 7) and send them directly to the YLK Program Director, Courtney Hutchins: chutchins@leadknox.com in PDF format with the student's name followed by either "educator reference.pdf" or "community reference.pdf". Example: SallySmithEducatorReference.pdf or SallySmithCommunityReference.pdf
5. Request that your high school principal complete the permission form (page 8) and send it directly to Leadership Knoxville in PDF format to chutchins@leadknox.com.
6. If needed, complete the scholarship application, which can be downloaded at www.leadershipknoxville.com/youthleadership/application or notify the YLK Program Director.

Click on the YLK link and then on the Application and Tuition tab. This form will not be part of the application reviewed by the Selection Committee.
